1 CHECK YOUR BLIND SPOTS

Motorcycles are smaller than other vehicles and can be even more difficult to spot while merging or changing lanes.

2 STAY IN YOUR LANE

Motorcycles are legally entitled to their own lane of traffic. Never "share" lanes with a motorcycle.

3 INTERSECTIONS ARE DANGEROUS

When you approach an intersection, come to a complete stop, view and obey traffic signs and signals, look both ways, and proceed slowly.
