The Distracted Driving Simulator provides a hands-on educational experience for drivers of all ages. Using virtual reality software, participants operate a stationary vehicle under various conditions including texting-while-driving, impaired driving and hazardous road conditions.

According to the SC Department of Public Safety, 1,036 people died on South Carolina highways in 2018. In 2018, South Carolina had the highest fatality rate in the nation for miles traveled, a staggering 62% higher than the national average. SCNCS is committed to ending distracted driving, the biggest contributing factor to crashes and fatalities.

- The Simulator operates best at outdoor events when the vehicle's engine can run; however, the setup can be modified to accommodate indoor events as well.
- Requires a minimum 20' x 20' space and a power source / outlet.
- Each attendee will spend 2-5 minutes in the Simulator. For larger events, please implement crowd control procedures, like stanchion lines.

Policy Information

- 50% deposit required at time of booking, and balance due on event date. There is a 3% processing fee for credit card payments.
